CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

The Kuwait International Family Medicine Conference (KIFMC) has firmly established itself as a premier event for advancing family medicine practices and fostering collaboration among healthcare professionals in the Gulf and beyond. The 3rd KIFMC, scheduled for April 24–27, 2025, at the Waldorf Astoria in Kuwait City, builds upon this legacy by offering a cutting-edge platform to explore the latest advancements in family medicine, promote sustainable healthcare practices, and elevate the quality of primary healthcare services.

The conference's overarching theme, "Excellence in Care" aims to enhance healthcare delivery in primary care and family medicine by addressing contemporary challenges, including the integration of technology, sustainable practices, and interdisciplinary collaboration.

This year, the conference's mission is to empower family physicians and general practitioners to become leaders of change in the healthcare system and to serve as the foundation of excellence in health for the communities they serve. To achieve this, the conference delivers sessions targeting daily clinical practice by offering up-to-date knowledge on the latest guidelines and best practices regarding chronic non-communicable diseases and obesity, as well as elevating clinical practice by incorporating artificial intelligence in decision-making and monitoring trends in practice. It also provides significant opportunities for professional growth by familiarizing general practitioners with the professional diploma program—an initiative endorsed by the World Health Organization to improve the proficiency of general practitioners in supporting the healthcare system. In addition, the conference offers workshops and training on home visits, wound care, motivational interviewing, and the management of diabetic foot, among many others, while also familiarizing physicians with other services that enhance care and quality of life, such as those provided by speech and language pathologists and physical medicine and rehabilitation specialists.

In terms of their administrative role, the conference offers lectures that empower physicians to become national and international leaders of organization- based initiatives by working in cooperation with multidisciplinary teams and decision-makers. These sessions discuss critical aspects such as risk management and psychological safety for both patients and medical staff. The conference also features pioneers in









their respective fields who discuss the critical role of family medicine in enhancing patient safety and public health. Moreover, it highlights how access to primary healthcare and the unique relationship between patients and family physicians enable them to be vital players in implementing strategies that promote health, screen for diseases, and monitor new epidemiological trends and emerging diseases.

Lastly, the conference emphasizes raising awareness among family physicians regarding community-centered care. Physicians are introduced to concepts such as health diplomacy, health in all policies, and disaster medicine. The program also underscores their role in the Healthy City initiative and how they can help achieve the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals by embracing sustainable, clean practices, offering better healthcare, and raising awareness about healthy living and environmental issues that affect health and infectious diseases.

By creating a multiple-tier program that covers all aspects of family medicine's practice, the conference aims to provide excellence in care by empowering physicians at the clinical, administrative, and community levels, while fostering continuous growth and innovation through research activities, including poster competitions, quality improvement projects, and audit competitions.



- Address the Growing Challenge of Obesity: Given its emerging impact in Kuwait, focus on community-level prevention and earlystage treatment through effective guidance and distinguished care in obesity clinics within primary healthcare.
- Enhance Awareness of Medical Ethics and Professionalism: Reflect the evolving social dynamics that impact both patients and physicians.

2. Regarding the Healthcare System:

Encourage Leadership in Primary Healthcare: Motivate providers to spearhead development and change by acquiring leadership and











management skills, including risk management and the development of policies and protocols.

- Promote Governance in Healthcare: Urge primary care physicians and decision-makers to adopt robust governance principles within the healthcare system.
- Raise Awareness of Medical Laws and Regulations: Highlight the importance of legal frameworks that safeguard patient rights and support physicians in advocating for their patients.
- Emphasize the Role of Medical Diplomacy: Illustrate how fostering international and intersectoral collaborations can contribute to better community health.
- Share Experiences on Digital Transformation: Discuss challenges, solutions, and outcomes from the "Partnership for Better Care" initiative, particularly regarding the use of digital technology to achieve comprehensive care, efficient resource management, and improved patient safety.
- Strengthen the Family Physician's Role in Public Health: Encourage the monitoring of trends, data analysis, future forecasting, and strategic planning to address emerging health challenges.
- Discuss the Vision for Public Health in the Gulf by 2030: Explore the pivotal role of family physicians in achieving this visionary framework.
- **Provide an Inclusive Supportive Environment:** Ensure that physicians and the broader medical team are empowered to fully contribute to the healthcare system and to have their rights upheld at work.
- Highlight the Importance of Governance: Stress how effective governance is key to achieving the highest standards of healthcare service delivery.

3. Regarding the Community:

- **Reinforce Community-Centered Care:** Address the health challenges faced by communities and outline the role of the family physician in addressing these issues.
- Utilize social media as a Tool for Health Education: Discuss how platforms shape public perceptions of health, treatment, and disease, and demonstrate how family physicians can leverage these tools to educate patients and enhance health awareness.
- Prepare Family Physicians for Crisis Response: Equip them with the skills necessary to be effective members of rapid response teams during disasters, natural crises, wars, and other emergencies, in light of regional political and environmental changes.




